Groundnut Outlook – September 2025

Groundnut is one of India's major oilseed crops, ranking second in both area and production after soybean (2024–25, Government of India). On the global stage, China is the leading producer of groundnut with an output of 19.27 million tonnes, accounting for 35% of the total world production of 54.31 million tonnes in 2023. India follows with 10.30 million tonnes (19%), trailed by Nigeria (4.30 million tonnes, 8%), the United States (2.67 million tonnes, 5%), and Myanmar (1.79 million tonnes, 3%). Within India, the major groundnut-producing states are Gujarat, Rajasthan, Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, and Tamil Nadu.

According to the third advance estimates for 2024–25, India's total groundnut production (including both kharif and rabi crops) is projected at 118.96 lakh tonnes, marking an increase from 101.80 lakh tonnes recorded in 2023–24. Among the states, Gujarat continues to lead with an estimated production of 51.81 lakh tonnes, followed by Rajasthan (21.24 lakh tonnes), Madhya Pradesh (15.75 lakh tonnes), Tamil Nadu (7.56 lakh tonnes), Karnataka (4.44 lakh tonnes), and Telangana (2.30 lakh tonnes).

According to the all India kharif crop coverage report, Government of India, as on 4th July 2025, groundnut was sown in around 26.74 lakh hectares as compared to last year (17.73 lakh ha). Among the states, Gujarat stood first in area coverage with 15.45 lakh ha followed by Rajasthan (6.90 lakh ha), Karnataka (0.93 lakh ha), Maharashtra (0.82 lakh ha) and Andhra Pradesh (0.25 lakh ha).

In Telangana, groundnut has been sown in around 7275 acres as on 28th August 2025. Among the districts, J Gadwal stood first in groundnut sown area with 4825 acres followed by Wanaparthy (1385 acres), Warangal (560 acres), B Kothagudem (190 acres) and Suryapet (98 acres). MSP for groundnut has been increased by Rs. 480 to Rs. 7263 per quintal for marketing season 2025-26 from Rs.6783 per quintal in 2024-25.

Groundnut Price Outlook

The groundnut seed market witnessed firm momentum during the week, supported by concerns over crop damage from heavy rainfall in some regions. However, in Rajkot mandi, weekly average prices inched up marginally by 0.3% from the previous week to Rs. 5,213 per quintal.

In terms of price trend, Rajkot groundnut prices declined by 2% over the past month, while showing gains of 8% in the last three months and 4% over six months. On a year-on-year basis, prices were down 5%, reflecting persistent long-term downward pressure.

Groundnut acreage in India has slipped this kharif season, with the sown area recorded at 43.98 lakh hectares as of August 15, 2025, a drop of 3.54% from 46.07 lakh hectares last year. The reduction is largely attributed to uneven rainfall disrupting sowing activity in several regions.

Under these circumstances, Agricultural Market Intelligence Centre, PJTAU expects that groundnut may trade in a range of **Rs. 5050–5450** per quintal during the month of September 2025.
