Eligibility

- A pass in two-year Intermediate Examination conducted by the Board of Intermediate Education or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto by the University or Intermediate Board with the following subjects namely:
 - Physical Sciences
 - Mathematics
- The selection of candidates for all the seats shall be made on the basis of ranks obtained by the candidates in **Telangana EAPCET-2025** in their respective local areas out of the merit list prepared for this purpose. The candidates will be selected based on merit by following rule of reservation.
- The candidates for admission to these courses shall be required to have completed 17 years of age with an upper age limit of 22 years for all the candidates, 25 years in respect of SC and ST candidates and 27 years for Physically Handicapped candidates as on 31st December of the year of admission.

Criteria for selection:

- The selection of candidates for all the seats shall be made on the basis of ranks obtained by the candidates in the **Telangana EAPCET-2025** conducted by the **Telangana Council for Higher Education**.

- In case of a tie in ranks obtained by two or more candidates in the Telangana EAPCET-2025, the marks secured in the optional subjects of the qualifying examination (Intermediate or its Equivalent Examination) shall be taken into consideration. In case of a further tie, the age of the candidate shall be taken into consideration and the older candidate shall be given preference.

Reservation of Seats:

- The rule of reservation (OC:46%, EWS:10%, BC-A:7%, BC-B:10%, BC-C:1%, BC-D:7%, BC-E:4%, SC-Group-I : 1%, SC-Group-II : 9% , SC-Group-III: 5%, ST:10%) will be followed as per the guidelines issued by the Government of Telangana from time to time).
- **The rule of reservation in respect of EWS will be followed as per the guidelines issued by the Government of Telangana from time to time.**

❖ **Reservation of seats under Farmer's/Agriculture Labourers'/Rural quota**

The seats for the candidates coming from the families of Agriculturalists cum Rural area (Farmers' Quota), and Agriculture Labourers' (Agriculture Labourers' Quota), and Rural Area alone (Rural Quota) have been reserved in various UG courses being offered by PJTAU. The details on the reservation percentage of the seats under Farmer's, Agriculture Labourers' and Rural quotas in UG courses are given below.

Note:

- **ANNEXURE-I:** It is a proforma to be certified by the Head of the Institution(s) with his office seal that the candidate has studied for a minimum period of four years in schools located in Non-Municipal areas (**Non-Municipal Area Certificate**).
 - **ANNEXURE-II:** It is a proforma indicating the patta numbers and extent of land owned by the candidate/parent(s), duly certified by the Tahsildar with his office seal (or) attested photocopies of Pattadar Pass Book as evidence of the extent of agricultural land.
 - **ANNEXURE-III:** It is a proforma indicating the Job card (EGS card) number of the candidate/parent(s) and certifying that the candidate/parents/grandparents **do not own any Agricultural Land**, duly certified by the Tahsildar with his office seal.
 - **ANNEXURE-I/ANNEXURE-II/ANNEXURE-III** need to be filled in with the signatures of concerned officials viz., Head of respective Institution(s) and Tahsildar, respectively, along with the office seal. Otherwise, the claim of the candidates under respective categories will be summarily rejected.
- Reservation of seats for the candidates coming from Rural Area (Rural Quota) in B.Sc. (Hons.) Community Science (Regular) course:**
- **Forty per cent (40%) of the seats** are reserved for candidates who have studied for a minimum of 4 years in schools located in Non-Municipal areas.
 - **ANNEXURE -I:** It is a proforma to be certified by the **Head Master** of the School with his office seal that the candidate has studied for a **minimum period of four years in schools located in Non-Municipal areas** during their period of study from 1st class to 12th class / Intermediate (**Non-Municipal Area Certificate**) (**ANNEXURE – I**).

- **ANNEXURE -I** need to be filled in with the **signatures of concerned officials viz., concerned Head of Institution respectively**, along with office seal. Otherwise, the claim of the candidates under this category will be summarily rejected.

Reservation of Special category seats:

- The counselling for the Physically Challenged (PH@5%), Children of Armed Personnel (CAP@2%), National Cadet Corps (NCC@1%) & SPORTS (@0.5%) quota seats shall be conducted in presence of the Officers of the departments concerned. The certificates of the candidates of above special categories shall be verified by the officers and the seats will be allotted as per the priorities indicated by them. The University has no interference in indicating priorities.

❖ **Reservation of seats for Women:**

- In each course, 33 $\frac{1}{3}$ % of the seats shall be horizontally reserved in favour of women candidates from each category.

Allocation of seats:

- Of the total seats, 85% of the seats are reserved for local candidates, and 15% of seats are unreserved.

In this regard, as per the G.O. Ms. No. 15 of the Higher Education (TE) Department, Dated: 27-02-2025, the reservation of seats is as follows:

Admission to 85% of the seats shall be reserved in each course in the Educational Institutions in the State for local candidates of OU area as specified in the Andhra Pradesh Educational Institutions (Regulations and Admissions) Order, 1974 as subsequently amended and the remaining 15% of the seats shall be un-reserved seats to the following:

- a. All the candidates are eligible to be declared as local candidates of the O.U. area.
- b. Candidates who have resided in the State for a total period of ten years, excluding periods of study outside the State, or either of whose parents has resided in the State for a total period of ten years, excluding periods of employment outside the State;
- c. Candidates who are children of parents who are in the employment of this State or Central Government, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities, and other similar quasi-public institutions within the State; and
- d. Candidates who are spouses of those in the employment of the State or Central Government, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and educational institutions recognized by the Government or a University or other competent authority, and similar other quasi-Government institutions within the State.

Note: The guidelines issued by the Government of Telangana from time to time shall be followed scrupulously, including the reservations for 15% of seats under the un-reserved quota.

Hostel facility :

- Hostel facility shall be provided, subject to the availability of accommodation in the respective colleges.

Original certificates to be produced at the time of counselling:

- SSC Memorandum of Marks or Equivalent Examination Certificate, showing the evidence of the Date of Birth.
- Pass Certificate cum Memorandum of Marks obtained by the applicant in the qualifying examination (Intermediate (10+2) or its Equivalent Examination.
- Telangana EAPCET-2025 Rank Card of Engineering Stream.
- Bonafide / Study Certificate from 4th to 12th Class.
- Transfer Certificate of the institute last studied.
- Residence Certificate of Telangana.
- The certified copy of the Social Status Certificate issued by the competent authority of Telangana in case of applicants belonging to Backward Classes, Scheduled Castes, and Scheduled Tribes.
- The latest certified copy of the **EWS Certificate valid for the year 2025-26** issued by the

- competent authority in case of applicants belonging to the EWS category.
- Non-Municipal Area Study Certificate (ANNEXURE-I), if applicable.
- Agricultural Land Holding Certificate (ANNEXURE-II), if applicable.
- Legal heir certificate, if applicable.
- Certificate claiming Agriculture Labourers' quota (ANNEXURE-III), if applicable.
- The certified copy of the Physically Challenged Certificate, if applicable.
- Children of Armed Personnel Certificate/Defence Personnel Certificate, if applicable.
- National Cadet Corps (NCC) Certificate, if applicable.
- Sports and Games Certificates along with Form I, II, III & IV (whichever is applicable), which are mandatory for claiming a seat under the Sports quota, if applicable.

Fee structure:

Note: The **hostel and mess** charges are additional.

- The rules and regulations with regard to eligibility, age, reservations etc., are the same that are applicable to the candidates admitted under general quota.
- The candidates selected under self-financing quota will be treated on par with regular students. No special amenities or facilities will be provided.
- The self-financing seats will be filled by separate counselling after filling up of regular seats.**
- The unfilled seats under self-financing quota will not be filled up from any other stream and will be kept vacant.
- The candidates admitted under this quota are not eligible for any reimbursement of fee or educational concessions offered by the Government.

Important Instructions:

- This notification shall be treated as individual intimation. No separate intimation will be sent.
- Open Competition includes all categories viz., OC, BC, SC-1, SC-II, SC-III & ST (by merit only).
- The candidates are required to produce all the relevant original certificates at the time of counselling failing which the candidature for admission will be disqualified.
- If the admitted candidate cancels his/her seat before closure of admission process, the entire fee collected from the student shall be refunded in full after deducting Rs 2000/- as processing fee.**
- Any cancellation/withdrawal of admissions after the closure of admission process, the candidate shall forfeit the entire fees (Except the caution deposits) in addition, the candidate has to pay the Rs 2000/- as processing fee.**
- Selection of candidates under BC, SC-I, SC-II & SC-III & ST quota is subject to clearance by the respective social status by the respective Directorates of Government of Telangana.
- The guidelines issued by Government of Telangana from time to time shall be followed scrupulously.

- Candidates called for counselling shall have to attend at their own cost and only one parent / guardian of the candidate will be allowed to accompany the candidate during counselling.
- The University doesn't guarantee any employment to the candidates joining the course.
- Candidates are required to read the prospectus thoroughly before attending the counselling.
- More number of candidates than availability of seats are called for Counselling and hence mere attendance / participation during counselling does not guarantee admission.
- Candidates should report at the Counselling center one hour before the scheduled time.
- Certificates / documents other than those uploaded will not be entertained or considered for the allotment of seats.
- Candidates belonging to BC, SC-I, SC-II, SC-III & ST Categories should bring two sets of Xerox copies of their caste certificate to be submitted at the counselling center.
- The Counselling under special categories (PH, CAP, NCC & Sports) will be held in the presence of authorities concerned.
- **The candidates selected for admission should submit Medical fitness certificate at the time of reporting in the college.**
