All the applicants in merit list under PwD category in the above Major Subjects are advised to report to the **O/o Controller of Examination Center, PJTAU, Rajendranagar, Hyderabad on 07-11-2025 at 10.00 AM** with all their original certificates, Passport size photos (2 sets) and prescribed fee as given in the Information Booklet.

### Reservation for Person with Disabilities (Pw.D)

The candidates seeking reservation under this quota will be required to present himself/herself before a Selection Committee constituted for the purpose to examine the suitability of the candidates to the various courses. The decision of the Selection Committee with regard to suitability shall be final. The candidates seeking admission into Ph.D. courses of PJTAU will be required to perform a few activities as part of the selection process.

1. The **5%** of the total seats reserved in each course in each faculty for the Persons with Disabilities (PwD.) shall be allocated among various departments of the concerned faculties by following the roster system (comparing weightage (number of seats) for major field of

study in the decreasing order and in case of same weightage, alphabetical order of major field of study will be followed for seat allotment).

- If no PwD candidates are available in the reserved major field of study such vacant seat shall be filled with non-PwD candidate of the same category in the same major field of study where the seat has been reserved for PwD.
- Further, if the seat remains still vacant they shall be filled-up as per the rule of reservation within the same major field of study only.
- If still further vacancy arises, the vacant seats will not be filled by the PwD candidates who appeared for the entrance exam in other major field of study.
- 2. The candidates seeking reservation under this quota will be required to present himself/herself before a Selection Committee constituted for the purpose to examine the suitability of the candidates to the various courses. The decision of the Selection Committee with regard to suitability shall be final. The candidates seeking admission into PG courses of PJTAU will be required to perform a few activities as part of the selection process.

#### a. Visually Handicapped (VH) (1%): Priority one

Screening Tests: **Task 1**: Reading the information on blackboard/whiteboard from a distance of 9/12/15 feet; **Task 2**: Writing a small paragraph; **Task 3**: Identification of slides through Microscope

#### **b.** Hearing Impaired (HI) (1%): Priority two

Screening Tests: **Task 1**: Listening and writing the word/sentence; **Task 2**: Listening and doing the practical work; **Task 3**: Listening and writing the answers to the questions.

### c. Orthopedically Handicapped (OH) (1%): Priority three

Screening Tests: **Tasks:** Operation of push/wheel hoes, walking on the bunds, spraying with knapsack/power sprayer, weeding & digging and irrigating the fields

#### d. Mental Illness (1%): Priority four

Autism, Intellectual disability, Specific learning disability and mental Illness.

### e. Multiple Disability (1%): Priority Five

Multiple disability form amongst persons under clauses (a) to (d) including deafblindness in the posts identified for each disabilities.

- As per the eligibility criteria, candidates seeking admission into PG and Ph.D courses must have passed the relevant UG and PG courses from accredited institutions by ICAR. Hence, applicants are informed to produce proof of accreditation certificates of their College & University concerned without fail for consideration of their admission into the courses concerned.
- This information shall be treated as an individual intimation.
- The applicants are informed that mere appearing his/her name in the merit list does not guarantee the admission and cannot claim the eligibility.
- The candidature for admission shall be based on the eligibility criteria as specified in the Information Booklet of the University.
- The selected candidates will have to pay the requisite fees including deposits immediately failing which the seat will stand cancelled.
- Candidates called for scrutiny and verification of application shall have to attend at their own
  cost and only one parent / guardian of the candidate will be allowed to accompany the
  candidate.
- The University doesn't guarantee any employment to the candidates joining the course.
- Candidates are required to read the Information Booklet thoroughly before attending the verification process and ensure that he / she has fulfilled the eligibility criteria for admission into courses concerned as per ICAR guidelines.
- The candidates selected for admission should submit medical fitness certificate at the time of reporting in the college.
- In case, the information furnished or the certificates uploaded by the candidates are found to be false, the University will take appropriate action against the individuals concerned
- Hostel facility will be provided subject to the availability
