- 1. All the applicants are called for counselling, hence there is no guarantee that all the candidates who attend the counselling shall get seats.
- 2. The parents and candidates should visit the University website www.pjtau.edu.in for updates and the availability of seats under various categories.
- 3. Vacancies if any arise, even on the date of the counselling also will be considered for admission process.
- 4. The parents and candidates are requested to attend the counselling based on the vacancy position and availability of seats.
- 5. If vacant seats are available and if candidates of one particular social category are not available for admission, such seats will be shifted to another social category as per the rule of reservation. Hence, all the applicants of all categories (OC, BC-A, BC-B, BC-C, BC-D, BC-E, SC-Group-I, SC-Group-II, SC-Group-III & ST Both Rural, Non-Rural, Farmers & Non-Farmers) may attend the counselling.
- **6.** The guidelines issued by Government of Telangana from time to time shall be followed scrupulously.
- * Reservation of seats under Farmer's/Agriculture Labourers'/Rural quota

The seats for the candidates coming from the families of Agriculturalists cum Rural area (Farmers' Quota), and Agriculture Labourers' (Agriculture Labourers' Quota), and Rural Area alone (Rural Quota) have been reserved in various UG courses being offered by PJTAU, PVNRTVU and SKLTGHU. The details on the reservation of the seats under Farmer's, Agriculture Labourers' and Rural quotas in UG courses are given below.

Note:

- ➤ <u>ANNEXURE-I</u>: It is a proforma to be certified by the Head of the Institution(s) with his office seal that the candidate has studied for a minimum period of four years in schools located in Non-Municipal areas (Non-Municipal Area Certificate).
- > ANNEXURE-II: It is a proforma indicating the patta numbers and extent of land owned by the candidate/parent(s), duly certified by the Tahsildar with his office seal (or) attested photocopies of Pattadar Pass Book as evidence of the extent of agricultural land.
- > ANNEXURE-III: It is a proforma indicating the Job card (EGS card) number of the candidate/parent(s) and certifying that the candidate/parent(s)/grandparent(s) do not own any Agricultural Land, duly certified by the Tahsildar with his office seal.
- ➤ ANNEXURE-I/ANNEXURE-II/ANNEXURE-III need to be filled in with the signatures of concerned officials viz., Head of respective Institution(s) and Tahsildar, respectively, along with the office seal. Otherwise, the claim of the candidates under respective categories will be summarily rejected.

- 3. Pass Certificate cum Memorandum of Marks obtained by the applicant in the qualifying examination (Intermediate (10+2) or its Equivalent Examination).
- 4. Telangana EAPCET-2025 Rank Card of Agriculture Stream.
- 5. Bonafide/Study Certificate(s) from 1st to 12th Class.
- 6. Transfer Certificate of the institute last studied.
- 7. Residence Certificate of Telangana.
- 8. The certified copy of the Social Status Certificate issued by the competent authority of Telangana in case of applicants belonging to Backward Classes, Scheduled Castes, and Scheduled Tribes.
- 9. The latest certified copy of the **EWS** Certificate valid for the year 2025-26 issued by the competent authority in case of applicants belonging to the EWS category.
- 10. Non-Municipal Area Study Certificate (ANNEXURE-I), if applicable.
- 11. Agricultural Land Holding Certificate (ANNEXURE-II), if applicable.
- 12. Legal heir certificate, if applicable.
- 13. Certificate claiming Agriculture Labourers' Quota (ANNEXURE-III), if applicable.
- 14. If the candidate has joined in any of the college of PJTAU, PVNRTVU & SKLTGHU during the previous phases of allotment he/she has to submit the following documents:
 - i. Copy of Admission letter.
 - ii. Custodian certificate of the institute joined.
 - iii. Fee receipt of the respective college.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS: -

- The following candidates are eligible for the counselling:
 - Who secured a seat in earlier phase of counseling and wish to move to some other colleges as per their merit and rule of reservation
 - Candidates who participated in earlier phase of counseling and could not secure a seat.
 - Candidates who did not participate in the earlier phase.
 - Candidates who were allotted a seat but didn't report/pay the fee at the college.
 - A candidate allotted a seat in earlier phase but cancelled his/her admission.
- Candidates are required to read the prospectus thoroughly before attending the counselling.
- > Vacancies if any arise, even on the date of the counselling also will be considered for admission process.
- > The parents and candidates should visit the University website www.pjtau.edu.in regularly during the counselling dates for updates.
- > All the candidates are informed to visit the website (www.pjtau.edu.in) for seat availability position before attending the counselling, which will be updated regularly during the counselling days.
- This notification shall be treated as an individual intimation and no separate intimation shall be issued
- > All Categories means the candidate belonging to OC, EWS, BC, SC-Group-I, SC- Group-II, SC- Group-III and ST including Non-Rural, Rural, Non-Farmer and Farmer.
- > The candidates need to attend the counselling on the scheduled day as per the ranks indicated above.
- The candidates are informed that the duration of B.V.Sc. & A.H. course is of 5 ½ years as per the recent regulations of Veterinary Council of India, New Delhi. The pattern of education for B.V.Sc. & A.H. course shall be on annual system basis.
- > The candidates are required to produce all the relevant original certificates at the time of counselling failing which the candidature for admission shall be rejected.

> The selected candidates will have to pay the requisite fees inclusive of deposits immediately failing which the seat shall stand cancelled.

- * The Lab/Library/Hostel/Mess deposits (refundable), mess & hostel charges are additional/extra.
- ➤ If the admitted candidate cancels his/her seat before the closure of admissions for the Academic Year 2025-26 an amount of Rs.10,000/- shall be collected as processing fee. The remaining fees already paid during admission shall be refunded.
- ➤ If the admitted candidate cancels his/her seat after closure of admissions process for the AY 2025-26 the candidate forfeits the fees already paid (except the caution deposits) and in addition, he/she has to pay an amount of Rs. 10,000/- towards processing fee.
- ➤ No refund of fee shall be made after closure of admissions process for the AY 2025-26.
- The **hostel and mess** charges are additional/extra.
- ➤ If the admitted candidate cancels/withdraws his/her seat <u>before the closure of admission</u> <u>process</u>, the entire fee collected from the student shall be refunded in full after deducting Rs. 2,000/- (Rs. 10,000/- for Special quota) as processing fee.
- Any cancellation/withdrawal of admissions <u>after the closure of the admission process</u>, the candidate shall forfeit the entire fees (except the caution deposits). In addition, the candidate has to pay Rs. 2,000/- (Rs. 10,000/- for Special quota) as processing fee.
- ➤ Selection of candidates under EWS, BC, SC-Group-I, SC-Group-II, SC-Group-III & ST quota is subject to clearance of the respective social status by the respective Directorates of Government of Telangana.
- > In the event of establishment of new colleges such seats shall also be considered for filling up through this notification only.
- > The guidelines issued by Government of Telangana from time to time shall be followed scrupulously.
- ➤ Counselling is held manually, not online counselling.
- > Candidates called for counselling shall have to attend at their own cost and only one parent / guardian of the candidate will be allowed to accompany the candidate during the counselling process.
- > The Universities do not guarantee any employment to the candidates joining the courses.
- > The counseling process is likely to extend late into the evening; hence the candidates and parents/ guardians are requested to come well prepared for the same.

- > More number of candidates than the availability of seats are called for counseling and hence, mere attendance / participation during counselling does not guarantee admission.
- > Candidates should report at the counselling center one hour before the scheduled time.
- ➤ Candidates belonging to EWS, BC, SC-Group-I, SC- Group-II, SC- Group-III & ST categories should bring two Xerox copies of their relevant certificate to be submitted at the counselling center.
- > The seats reserved under EWS/BC/ SC-Group-I/SC- Group-II/SC- Group-III/ST categories including farmers quota shall also be filled up simultaneously during the counseling process on the scheduled days.
- ➤ A candidate for admission under general category to B.V.Sc. & A.H. degree course, must have passed in the subjects of English, Physics, Chemistry & Biology and obtained 50% (47.5% for SC/ST/PH category) of marks at the intermediate level in each subject.
- > Sliding and shifting from one course to another course and one college to another college shall be done based on the merit and rule of reservation and availability of seats.
- > In the event of sliding from one course to another course and one college to another college the candidates need to pay the differential amounts of fees as per the fee structure of the respective Universities.
- > 20% of seats in B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture under ICAR quota shall be filled up based on ranks obtained in UG-CUET-2025 National level examination conducted by National Testing Agency.
- ➤ The left over seats under ICAR quota shall be filled up by the University.
- > In case, the information furnished or the certificates uploaded by the candidates are found to be false, the University shall take appropriate legal action against the individuals concerned.
- > The University is not responsible for any information provided in the websites other than at www.pjtau.edu.in.
- Parents and Students are informed that the admissions are purely based on merit and guidelines of the University and as such they are requested not to rely on any middlemen/persons/consultants who try to mislead the students in securing admission into PJTAU under any quota. All the seats shall be filled by the University only through combined counselling.
- > The candidates may take original certificates on request by furnishing an undertaking, if they have any other counsellings to be attended and return the certificates after the stipulated day. If they fail to return the certificates to the college, the admission shall stand cancelled. No correspondence in this regard shall be entertained.
- > The selected candidates are advised to take mobile numbers of the concerned officers of the allotted college for official information.
- > Candidates are informed to attend counselling on the scheduled date and time. If they fail to attend they cannot claim the seat as per merit.
- > Candidates, if attend the counselling late, they shall have to submit the letter to the counselling authorities duly indicating the time of their attending the counselling.
