Eligibility:

- i) Pass in SSC or its equivalent examination or
- ii) Qualified in TG-POLYCET 2025 (Agriculture stream) or
- iii) Qualified in TG-POLYCET 2025 (Engineering stream)

Criteria for selection (Priority):

- Priority 1: The selection of candidates for all the seats shall be made on the **basis of ranks obtained by the candidates under Agriculture Stream** in the Telangana **TG-POLYCET-2025** conducted by SBTET.
- Priority 2: The selection of candidates for all the seats shall be made on the **basis of ranks obtained by the candidates under Engineering Stream** in the
 Telangana **TG-POLYCET-2025** conducted by SBTET
- Priority 3: The OGPA obtained in SSC or its equivalent examination for applicants without TG-POLYCET-2025 ranks
 - ➤ In case of tie the grade point obtained in first Science and later Maths, English, Telugu, Social and Hindi will be taken into consideration.
 - ➤ If tie continues, the age of the candidates shall be taken into consideration and the older candidates shall be given preference for the seat.
- **❖** Candidates who have already applied need not apply again and may attend the counselling.

Age:

Candidates for admission into these courses in the University shall be required to have completed 15 years of age as on the year of admission (as on 31-12-2025) with an upper age limit of 22 years.

Reservation of the seats:

The rule of reservation (OC:46%, BC-A:7%, BC-B;10%, BC-C:1%, BC-D:7%, BC-E:4%, SC-Group-I:1%, SC- Group-II:9%, SC- Group-III:5%, ST:10%) shall be followed as per the rules. Similarly, the 10% reservation allocated to EWS category is supernumerary to the total intake (*The rule of reservation shall be followed as per the guidelines issued by the Government of Telangana from time to time*).

❖ Reservation of seats under Rural/Government school quota

Sixty per cent (60%) of the seats in various diploma courses of PJTAU are reserved for candidates coming from Rural area/Government Schools. The details of eligibility and documents to be submitted are as follows.

➤ <u>ANNEXURE-I</u>: It is a proforma to be certified by the Head of the Institution(s) with office seal that the candidate has studied for a minimum period of four years in schools located in Non-Municipal areas (Non-Municipal Area Certificate).

***** Reservation of seats under Special Categories:

The counselling for the **Physically Challenged** (PH@5%), **Children of Armed Personnel** (CAP@2%), **National Cadet Corps** (NCC@1%) and **Sports** (@0.5%) quota seats shall be conducted in the presence of the Officers of the departments concerned. The certificates of the candidates of the above special categories shall be verified by the officers, and the seats shall be allotted as per the priorities indicated by them. The University has no interference in indicating the priorities.

a. Reservation under Physically Handicapped Quota:

In various Diploma courses offered by PJTAU, 5% of seats are reserved for Physically Handicapped/Challenged candidates. The candidates seeking reservation under above quota shall be required to be present himself/herself before a Selection Committee comprising of Residential Medical Officer, Specialists in the concerned fields of medicine and Dean of Agriculture, who shall examine the suitability of the candidates to the various courses. As a part of the selection process, the candidates seeking admission into various diploma courses of PJTAU shall be required to perform the activities such as identification of slides

As a part of the selection process, the candidates seeking admission into various diploma courses of PJTAU shall be required to perform the activities such as identification of slides through microscopes, operation of push/wheel hoes and walking on the bunds, spraying with knapsack/power sprayer, weeding & digging, irrigating the fields, reading from the blackboard, writing, threading the needle, hearing tests etc,

b. Reservation under Sports Quota:

As per G.O.Ms No. 2 of the Govt. of Telangana dated 22-09-2020, 0.5% of seats have been reserved under the Sports quota. A total of 31 Sports Disciplines have been indicated in the said G.O. All the candidates who wish to seek admissions in various Diploma courses of PJTAU are required to upload a copy of his/her sports achievements/ testimonials along with the Form I, II, III & IV (whichever is applicable) duly certified/attested by the concerned State Sports Associations recognized by the SATS which are categorized according to level of the Championships. *Uploading of Form I, II, III & IV* (whichever is applicable) is mandatory, otherwise, the candidates shall not be considered under the Sports Quota. The above forms are also made available in the Online Admission application form.

The scrutiny of sports applications along with Form I, II, III & IV (as applicable) shall be done by the competent authority and subsequently by an evaluation committee for finalizing the priorities for allotment of the seats.

***** Reservation of seats for Women:

 \triangleright In each course, $33\frac{1}{3}\%$ of the seats shall be horizontally reserved in favour of women candidates from each category.

I. Allocation of seats:

➤ Of the total seats, 85% of the seats are reserved for local candidates, and 15% of seats are unreserved.

In this regard, as per the G.O. Ms. No. 15 of the Higher Education (TE) Department, Dated: 27-02-2025, the reservation of seats is as follows:

Admission to 85% of the seats shall be reserved in each course in the Educational Institutions in the State for local candidates of OU area as specified in the Andhra Pradesh Educational Institutions (Regulations and Admissions) Order, 1974 as subsequently amended and the remaining 15% of the seats shall be un-reserved seats to the following:

- a. All the candidates are eligible to be declared as local candidates of the O.U. area.
- b. Candidates who have resided in the State for a total period of ten years, excluding periods of study outside the State, or either of whose parents has resided in the State for a total period of ten years, excluding periods of employment outside the State;
- c. Candidates who are children of parents who are in the employment of this State or Central Government, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities, and other similar quasipublic institutions within the State; and
- d. Candidates who are spouses of those in the employment of the State or Central Government, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and educational institutions recognized by the Government or a University or other competent authority, and similar other quasi-Government institutions within the State.

<u>Note:</u> The guidelines issued by the Government of Telangana from time to time shall be followed scrupulously, including the reservations for 15% of seats under the Unreserved quota.

II. Hostel facility:

➤ Hostel facility shall be provided, subject to the availability of accommodation in the respective polytechnics.

III. <u>Fees:</u>

a. The fee particulars of Diploma courses to be paid at the time of admission are as follows:

- 1. If the admitted candidate cancels his/her seat <u>before the closure of admissions</u> for the AY 2025-26 an amount of Rs. 2,000/- shall be collected as processing fee. The remaining fees already paid during admission shall be refunded.
- 2. If the admitted candidate cancels his/her seat <u>after the closure of admissions</u> process for the AY 2025-26 the candidate forfeits the fees already paid and in addition, he/she has to pay processing of Rs. 2,000/-.
- 3. The payment of the application fee for SC/ST/PH candidates is Rs. 600/-, while for other candidates, it is Rs. 1200/-.

Original certificates to be produced at the time of Counselling/Admission:

- 1. SSC Memorandum of Marks or Equivalent Examination Certificate.
- 2. TG-POLYCET-2025 Rank Card if applicable.
- 3. Bonafide / Study Certificate from 4th to 10th Class.
- 4. Non-Municipal Area Study Certificate (ANNEXURE-I) if applicable.
- 5. The latest certified copy of the Social Status (Caste) Certificate issued by the competent authority in case of applicants belonging to Backward Classes, Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes if applicable.
- 6. The latest certified copy of the **EWS Certificate valid for the year 2025-26** issued by the competent authority, in case of applicants belonging to the EWS category.
- 7. The certified copy of the Physically Challenged Certificate, if applicable.
- 8. Children of Armed Personnel Certificate / Defence Personnel Certificate, if applicable.
- 9. National Cadet Corps (NCC) certificate, if applicable.
- 10. Sports and Games Certificates (Form-I/Form-III/Form-III/Form-IV as applicable), if applicable.

- > Candidates are informed that attending for counselling does not guarantee the allotment of seat.
- > Candidates called for counselling will have to attend at their own cost only. One of the Parents / Guardian of the candidate shall be allowed for counselling.
- > The candidate who secures a seat, should submit the certificates in Original along with the prescribed fees at the time of counselling itself.
- ➤ In case, the information furnished or the certificates uploaded by the candidates are found to be false, the University **will take appropriate action** against the individuals concerned and his/her application will be summarily rejected.
- ➤ The candidate should visit the University website (<u>www.pjtau.edu.in</u>) frequently for updated and latest admission information.
- > Candidates are required to read the PROSPECTUS thoroughly before applying.
