Assessment Criteria and Methodology

1. The performance of the candidate should be consistently satisfactory as obtained in the annual appraisal (confidential) reports.
2. The process of promotions should involve inviting the biodata with duly filled comprehensive application based template and reprints of requisite number of publications of candidate wherever necessary. All supporting documents shall be verified and certified by the Head / Reporting Officer.
3. CAS promotions from a lower stage to higher stage of Assistant Professor shall be conducted by a “Screening cum Evaluation Committee” based on the comprehensive evaluation of individual achievements / competency levels during the assessment period.
4. The “Screening cum Evaluation Committee” for CAS promotion of Assistant Professor from Academic Level 10 to 11 of Rs.68,900-2,05,500 and from Academic level 11 to 12 of Rs.79,800-2,11,500 shall consist of
 - a) The Vice-Chancellor as the Chairman
 - b) One of the Directors/Deans-Member
 - c) The concerned University Head of the Department*– Member
 - d) One expert in the concerned subject nominated by the Vice-ChancellorThe quorum for the committee meeting shall be three including the subject expert and the Chairperson.

* In the absence of University Head of the Department, any other Professors or persons of the department nominated by the Vice Chancellor.

5. CAS promotion being a personal promotion to the incumbent teachers holding a substantive sanctioned post he/she has to take the work load of the post. On superannuation of the individuals incumbent, the said post shall revert back to its original cadre
6. For the promotion under the CAS, the applicant teacher must be on the role and in active service of the University/College on the date of consideration by the Selection Committee.
7. The overall promotion procedure shall be based on transparent, objective and credible methodology of analysis of the merit and credentials of the applicants keeping performance indicators as specified in the CAS guidelines as key approach for the assessment and his / her achievements / individual competency levels during the assessment period.
8. A teacher shall have earned annual increments regularly during the assessment period for CAS promotion.
9. The candidates who do not succeed in the first assessment, he/she shall have to be reassessed only after one year. When such a candidate succeeds in the eventual assessment, his/her promotion shall be deemed to be one year from the date of rejection.
10. Candidates who become eligible first time but do not apply in the event of overseas leave / deputation in foreign organizations / medical leave and any other such circumstances, when he / she applied in subsequent CAS for promotion, their date of eligibility shall be from the actual date of eligibility.
11. Teachers who desired to be considered for respective grade promotion shall submit to the Registrar the filled in application form prescribed for the purpose. ***The teacher shall present their justification based on their work carried out during the assessment period for consideration to the next promotion level along with supporting documents to the selection committee***
12. The composition of the Selection Committee for promotion from Academic Level 12 to 13A of Rs.1,31,400 - Rs. 2, 17,100 and from Academic Level of 13A to 14 of Rs. 1,44,200- Rs. 2,18,200, Academic level 14 to 15 Rs. 1,82,200-Rs. 2,24,100 shall be similar to that for direct recruitments.
13. The Screening cum Evaluation Committee on verification / evaluation of performance indicators secured by the candidates through comprehensive assessment system (Academic Level 11 and Academic Level 12) and the recommendations of the selection committee (Academic Level 13A, 14 and 15) shall recommend to the Board of Management about the suitability for the promotion of the candidate(s) under CAS for consideration and approval.
14. Previous regular service if any before entering the University will be considered if he / she served in academic / research institutions of public sector and drawn UGC pay scales, such services will be considered only if he / she applied through proper channel for the said post.
